Lesson 6: My special place		
Content focus: In this lesson each student identifies features that make a place special to him or her. They are asked to think about each of the senses as well as the appearance and uses of the place.		Resources: • Worksheet 1: Thinking about and drawings special places
 What makes a place special for a person? How can we look after that place? 	Outcomes: A student: Identifies features of a place that make it special to him/her.	 Step 1: Students are asked to think about a place that is special for them. It might be a room, a house, a play area, a relative's house, or a place they have visited. Step 2: Each child is given a copy of Worksheet 1 on which they draw things they like about the place. Step 3: The drawings can be displayed and children encouraged to talk about them. Step 4: A list of places (perhaps with photographs) could be used to pose the question of which people would see these places as special. The places could include: a beach, a fishing port, a national park trail, a farmhouse, a church etc.

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
