Lesson 5: From mountains to sea: Landforms of Asia – Literacy focus		
Content focus: In this lesson students focus on writing skills. The teacher uses a scaffold to model a description response. Students will peer review each other's work and provide specific feedback using a Feedback Ladder. Key inquiry questions: • What are the main landforms of Asia?	 Outcomes: A student: demonstrates an understanding of the directive term 'describe'. describes the characteristics of one Asian landform. 	Lesson sequence: Step 1: Literacy activity: The teacher provides students with scaffold for a descriptive report models a response using the example provided (see Worksheet 1) Step 2: Students choose one landform in Asia and complete a descriptive report of the landform. Step 3: Working in pairs, students read each other's description and using a Feedback Ladder (Resource Sheet 2) provide a comment on the description. Step 4: Students rewrite description incorporating the feedback they received. Alternative Task: Students use National Geographic Map Maker [https://mapmaker.nationalgeographic.org/#/] to identify the principal landforms and climate of Asia. Students look at the relationship between landforms and climate.

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
