In doing so, students:  Outline the nature of the environmental issues being studied Stage the causes of the environmental issue Describe the impact of the environmental issue on people and (if appropriate) plants and animals Outline the actions communities and authorities are taking to address the issue  Step 2: Ask the students to present their investigation's findings as an illustrated written report.
